

## SUGGESTED NAMING OPPORTUNITIES

Naming opportunities are offered in conjunction with the Library's facilities-update cycle (generally every ten years), with first right of renewal. They are recognized with prominently displayed signage on selected rooms/locations, and in the Library and Library Foundation's annual report, website and social media channels.

#### \$50,000

##### Children's Area

Provide a 1,986-square-foot children's area where kids and families can discover early-literacy and others skills in a fun and friendly environment.

#### \$25,000

##### Family Place

Based on a model of comprehensive family-centered services, a Family Place Library is a center for early childhood information, parent education, early literacy, socialization and family support. This will be the first of its kind in Jefferson County!

##### Story Time Area

Provide a Story Time space where children 0-5 can learn the skills they need to be ready to read when they enter kindergarten.

Naming opportunities are governed by Jefferson County Public Library policies and guidelines, subject to approval from the Library Board of Trustees and administered through the Jefferson County Library Foundation. ## EDGEWATER LIBRARY AT A GLANCE - FAST FACTS

**Service area:** More than 26,000 residents in zip code 80214

**Estimated # of households:** 11,291 from *Gale Cengage Learning*. Of those:

- 15.5% make less than \$15,000 per year
- 29.8% make less than \$24,999 per year
- 43.6% make less than \$34,999 per year
- 62.9% live in rental units
- 16.5% have no vehicles available

### Key stats from Jefferson Success Pathway:

- 9 in 10 Jeffco School students in the area qualify for free or reduced lunch
- Only 3 in 10 kindergartners demonstrate early literacy skills as they start school
- Only 2 in 10 3rd-grade students are reading at grade level by the end of 3rd grade
- Only 1 in 10 5th-grade students are at grade level in math at the end of 5th grade
- Only 1 in 10 8th-grade students are at grade level in math at the end of 8th grade
- Only 6 in ten graduate from high school

TEEN AREA

## \$20,000

### Quiet Reading Area

Provide a designated quiet area for reading, study and reflection. Area will include a wall of windows and a fireplace.

### Teen Area

Provide a designated 487-square-foot teen area with access to age appropriate resources and collaborative technology.

### Technology Access Center

Provide a designated area with access to public computers, laptops, software, and the Internet, as well as technology and tools to support business processes (printing, copying, scanning and faxing).

## \$10,000

### Laptops for checkout

Allow patrons to access and use laptops computers whenever they're in the Library.

## \$7,500

### Large Study Room

Provide a private study area where up to 4 people can meet and collaborate on projects.

## \$5,000

### Small Study Room(s)

Provide a private study area with collaborative technology for 1-2 people.

### Nursing Nook

Provide a private space where new mothers can nurse their children.

## SUGGESTED NAMING OPPORTUNITIES

Name recognition opportunities are offered for three years or the useful life of the asset (whichever comes first) with first right of renewal. They are recognized with signage affixed to the asset and in the Library and Library Foundation's annual report, website and social media channels.


