Population growth has outpaced library space throughout the county. Jefferson County Public Library (JCPL) has identified the need to build a new destination library in the southern region of the county to expand library services. 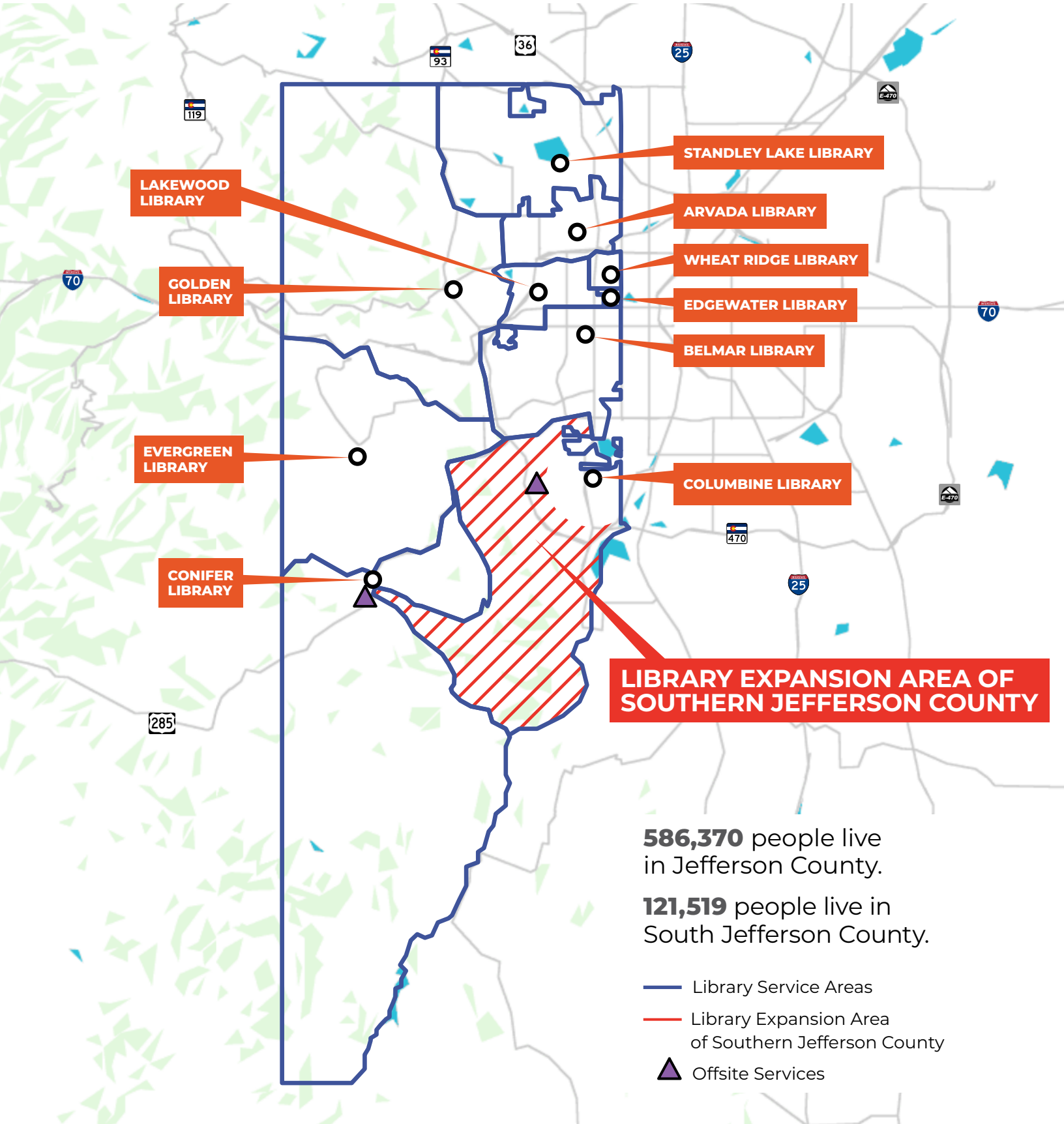
