
With A Library, A Community Forms

Northwest Jefferson County is a growing area with limited access to library services.

The expected growth rate for this area of Jefferson County is 36%, outpacing the 9% growth rate for the rest of the county.

Today, 10,800 households reside in this largely underserved area. By 2030, that number is expected to grow to 14,700.

This destination library will serve the needs of thousands of households and provide the resources this newly emerging community has yet to develop.



OUR NEW SITE

This 9.4-acre parcel of land, located between Wilkerson Ct., 92nd Dr., and Candelas Pkwy., will house the 30,000 sq. ft. Northwest Jefferson County Library. The location has sweeping views, convenient access and plenty of space to explore outdoor connection.
