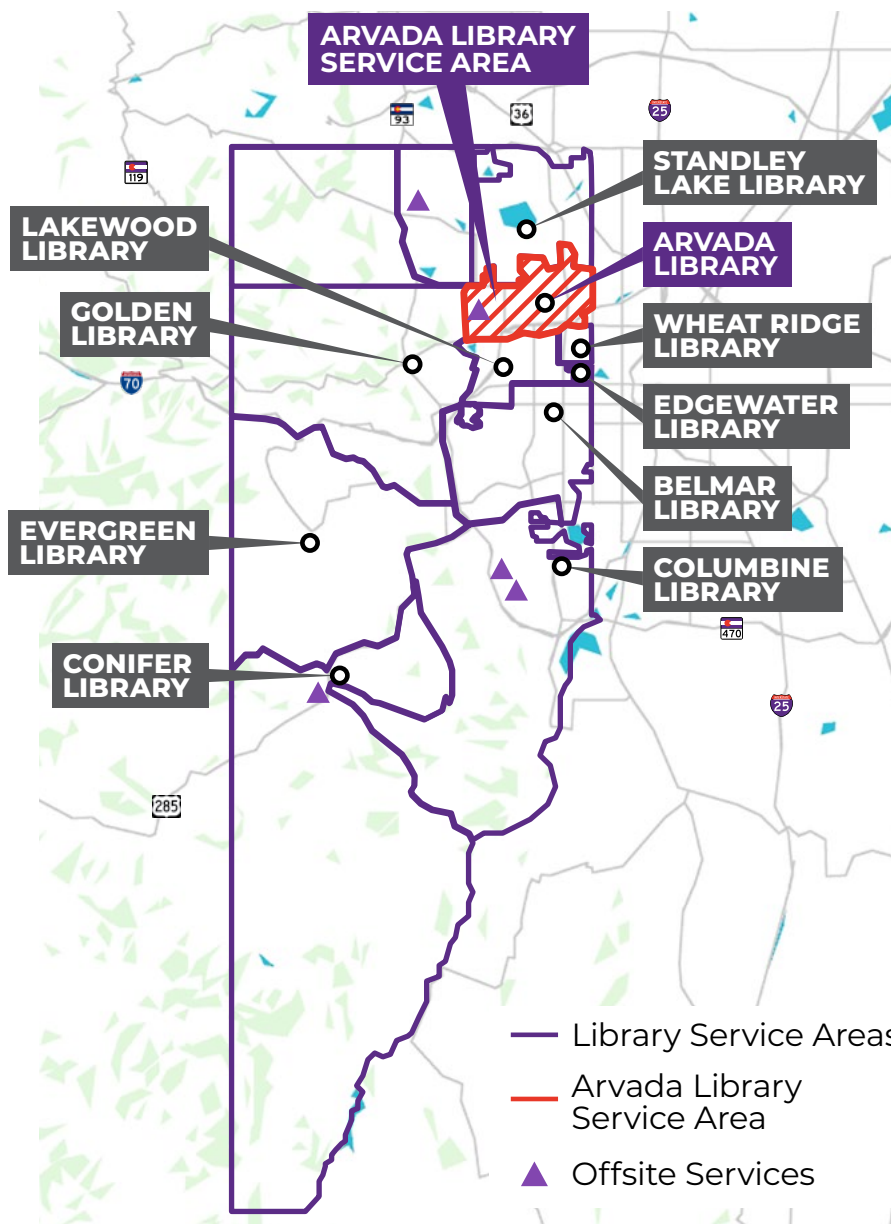




REIMAGINING THE ARVADA LIBRARY

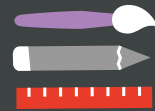

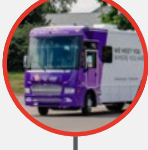

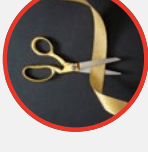

A MODERN DESIGN TO MATCH THE CHARACTER OF OLDE TOWN ARVADA

- **Welcoming:** Created a flexible third place for the entire community.
- **Transitional Style:** Blended traditional warm elements with modern, light spaces that reflect the urban/suburban Olde Town aesthetic.
- **Safe and Secure:** Increased sightlines, moved entryways, and integrated restrooms and meeting rooms into the main library space, adding a greater sense of safety.
- **Flexible:** Spaces designed to be easily adaptable for programs and gatherings to meet a variety of community needs.
- **Intuitive:** Clear landmarks, movement paths and a new, modernized elevator, to improve wayfinding and mobility.

ARVADA BALSAM TEMPORARY LIBRARY

During construction, patrons will still have limited access to books and DVDs, holds, computers and programming in the former home of Arvada K-8 School at **5751 Balsam Street, Arvada, CO 80002**. Named Arvada Balsam Temporary Library, this location is conveniently located just a two-minute drive or a 12-minute walk from the Arvada Library. It can easily be accessed from the 52-bus route at the W 58th Avenue & Carr Street stop, or a half-mile walk from the Olde Town Arvada G Line stop.
